

IVEF is a 501c3 nonprofit organization that works in partnership with the Souderton Area School District (SASD) to support educational programs for both the students and staff. IVEF works to set funding priorities and manage donations, directing philanthropic contributions toward the needs of the 6,500 students in our 9 schools.

Our work is critical for the children of this community and supports the future with an educated workforce. Smart investments in public schools offer the opportunity to introduce cutting-edge educational models that enhance SASD's current programs and advance learning outcomes for all students.

IVEF provides funds for educational programs and activities which are not funded by the school district's normal operating budget. IVEF funds are used to support student achievement and skill development, recognize and encourage staff innovation, and expand community involvement from individuals, businesses, and civic organizations.

Innovation Grant Program

The Innovation Grant Program, open to all SASD teachers and administrators, is a fantastic way to support the implementation of an innovative project or initiative in a classroom, grade level, or building.

Through our Innovation Grant program, we provide the funding needed to support teachers and help students embrace new ways of learning, solving problems, and working together. Faculty and administrators of SASD are invited to apply for grants to provide innovative offerings in their classrooms, which otherwise would not be supported by the school district budget. IVEF is committed to providing \$30,000 per year to this program.

The purpose of this program is to provide students who are seeking to pursue post-secondary education an affordable resource to prepare for the SATs.

The goal is to provide as many students as possible the chance to achieve their full potential. The IVEF is committed to being able to provide scholarships for students in need to take this class, giving them access to this opportunity.
